A tour of North Albuquerque including a cruise up **Rio Grande Boulevard** with exquisite homes and cottonwoods. We'll see the famous **Balloon Fiesta Park** grounds and stop at a **chile roasting stand**. The Sandia Mountains dominate the east side of Albuquerque. The top is 10,378' above sea level and typically 30 degrees cooler than the city. The **Sandia Peak Tram** holds 50 persons; the tram ride lasts 15-minutes and travels 3,800 vertical feet through biological life zones that equal a trip from Mexico to Alaska, revealing deep canyons and an awe-inspiring view not soon to be forgotten. Sunset that night is at 8:13.



This tour offers options: OPTION 1: Includes the Tram ride and a dinner reservation at High Finance Restaurant (at the top of the mountain 10,378').

OPTION 2: Includes the Tram ride, about 40 minutes on the mountaintop and then the tram ride to the base for a dinner reservation at (6,560') at Sandiago's Mexican Grill: coastal Mexican cuisine. OPTION 3: Is for people who should not travel to an elevation of 10,378' and does not include the Tram ride. The Option includes a dinner reservation at Sandiago's at the base of the Tram. It is still a beautiful view; you will be 1,200' higher than at your hotel.

Located one hour west of Albuquerque, Acoma Indian Pueblo "Sky City", is built upon a 70-acre mesa almost 40 stories above the canyon floor. We'll follow an Acoma Indian guide through the earthen streets as we hear their history and see why they maintain their ancestral home (occupied since the early 900'sAD) without electricity or modern plumbing. There will be

opportunities to purchase hand-crafted and home-baked items on the mesa top. At the visitor center we'll enjoy lunch at the café as well as spend time in the museum and gift shop.
